GWSD secretary has some questions regarding procedures for new accounts such as adding tamper proof locks, updating customer account numbers/accountability, collections and liens that will be implemented into the new bylaws.

- D) Review potential proposals for road maintenance and improvement The upgrades and improvements that GWSD has been doing in tying together to be able to show enough assets to justify a loan or grant in order to fund a road project. More time is needed.

With financial control in GWSD hands, Gamerco will pilot the regionalization to consolidate control in order to be able to acquire more funds to fund and promote projects that will benefit the people living in the regionalized communities.
